MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : New Prices and/or Rations for WFP Commodities
of Butter Oil, Powdered Skimmed Milk (packed
in bags) and Canned Butter

We are pleased to inform that the price of butter oil now in stock at the warehouses of systems or projects is being reduced from P1.00 to P.25 per kilogram.

We wish to inform also that the items of dried skimmed milk and canned butter came in packages not as anticipated. The new shipment of skimmed milk is contained in paper and plastic bags of about 25 kilograms net. And the canned butter, is in cans of 400 grams net and not in cans of 457 grams as expected.

In view of the above, the unit prices of the two WFP items as well as the allowable ration of each worker per quincena (11 working days) are being revised as follows:

Dried Skimmed Milk - - - - P1.05 per bag of 2 kilograms net

Canned butter - - - - P1.60 per can of 400 grams net or
P 3.20 for 2 cans.


We wish to remind that this reduced price of P1.05 per bag for skimmed milk is only true for the powdered skimmed milk packed in bags. The Skimmed Milk contained in cans of 2,268 grams net remains at its usual price of P2.50 per can.

Again, with respect to the milk packed in bags, it is directed that for sanitary reason and for convenience in the distribution, the same should be pre-weighed and packed in a weather proof plastic bag of 2,000 grams net, well ahead of the ration or pay day.

The above new prices are effective immediately, except for that of the butter oil which shall take effect September 1, 1969.

Provisions of previous Memo Circulars on WFP contrary to the foregoing are likewise deemed superseded.

Compliance is enjoined.
