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: Incentive Denusse and Cash Awards for Manional Invitation Refineers. Invitation Accordationdents, Churation and Mathemance Personnel and Collectors of Invitation Fees

<u>Purpose</u> - Incentive boundes and each averals are primarily intended to further imperved irrigation service and irrigation fee collections and give due recognition to deserving operation and maintenance powernel as well as collectors of irrigation fees.

In the implementation of this memorandum as approved by the Beard under Revolution No. 1249-70 dated March 9, 1970, and in accordance with Section 27 of Republic Act No. 2260, otherwise known as the Civil Service Act at 1959, as amonded, the following rules are hereby promulgated for the guidance and strict observance of all concerned:

I. Incontive Some for Collectors of Irrigetion Pees

A. Definition of Terms Veed

<u>Getton</u> - The territory covered by a Ditchtender or a Getekoeper.

<u>Jone</u> - some is the irrigable area under the supervision of one or white maternasters.

<u>Current Accounts</u> - Irrigation bills or charges which have been paid and/or collected when not yet subject to genalties in accordance with existing rules and regulations of MA.

<u>Rack Accounts</u> - Irrigation bills or charges which have been subjected to penalties.

<u>Economical for Examplion</u> - Defers to part or whole of inviction face/derges (including penalties, if any) that may be dropped (from collectibles which correspond to specific summe restanged for exampleon from the payment of invigation foos and paymenty reported to the Central Office.

Collogation Forled - Starts from July 1 of the preceding year to June 30 of the following year.

B. Collection Units and Second - Sach irrigation system shall be divided into collection zones. I, no case, however, shall a divigion be split in the formation of zones.

The Intration Superintendent shally formally organize the collection took if each zone which the composed of one date mester de bead and Ditchtenders and/or fatelcopers within the some as weathers. Under Soard Recolution No. 1249-70, the Irrigation Superintendent shell also include as members of the collection term, BVI/AFC percented recommended by the Director/Commissioner of said Offices who are verking in the same geographical area under his jurisdiction. He shall have supervision over these deputized employees from BVI/AFC only with regard to the collection of irrigation fees.

All members of the collection team should be duly designated and bonded as assistant irrigation collectors. They should also be on monthly basis.

C. Basis for Determination of Deemption

Basis of examplica shall be causes beyond the control of the farmer, such as typhoons, flood-subsergence, water shortage, rat infortation, wide-spread past infostation and Nrs.

<u>Determination of examption shall be:</u>

1. Partial - part of lot affected will be isolated and harvest thereon will be determined by sampling. If harvest in the affected area is less than 60% of hervest in the unaffected parties of the lot which is to be determined also by sampling, the affected area shell be recommended for exemption.

2. Total - (whole lot alfected) If the total harvest is less than 50% of the average yield in the section where the lot is located, the area of the whole lot will be recommended for exemption.

D. <u>Credit of Collection</u>

- 1. Collections of a team for service area within its some shall be credited 100%.
- 2. Collections of a team for service areas outside its some shall be credited 50% to said team and 50% to the other team covering that zone.
- 3. Collections of invigation focs/accounts in the Office shall be credited 50% to the team covering the none.

E. Collection Have

1. Computation of here for tens - Base for the sene shall be the total current irrigation fees for the energy irrigated within the neme. If some collections for service areas in the zene are not credited to the team as provided, the base shall be adjusted by deducting the arount collected but not credited.

2. <u>Connection of base for System</u> - Hase for the system shall be the total current irrightion fees for the areas irrighted, which in no case should be less than 90% of the corresponding maximum benefited area registered in the system since the agricultural year 1965-66. Approved examptions at the time of the computation of the bonness shall be deducted from the base. (If recommendation for examptions are submitted immediately after hervest, particularly for the 1st crop, there is a good chance of its being acted upon for consideration in the computation of the base.) 3. <u>Computation of Base for Region</u> - Base for the region shall be the total current irrigation fees for the areas irrigated in the region but in no case should it be less than 90% of the corresponding amount for the maximum benefited area registered in the region beginning Agricultural Year 1965-66.

F. Incentive for collection Teams

1. <u>Schedule of bonus from collections of current</u> <u>irrigation fees</u>:

For collections above 50% up to 70% of the base - 10% bonus For collections above 70% up to 85% of the base - 15% bonus For collections above 85% of the base - 20% bonus

2. <u>Conditions precedent to merit bonus for current</u> irrigation fees:

- a. Remittance of collection and submittal of collection reports on time (20th of each month except June). For first non-compliance in the System or Regional Office, the bonus shall be reduced by 50%; for second non-compliance, by 75%; and for third non-compliance, no bonus shall be given.
- b. For the purpose of attaining the minimum required collection of 45% of the Base for the systems, Nay and June collections, including the 10% penalties, may be included in the toal current irrigation fees collected. For systems with average lot area of less than 0.25 hectars and whose total service area is over 1,000 bectares, same conditions as above but the Base for the system is reduced to 40%.
- 3. <u>Schedule of bonus from collections of back irrige-</u> tion feest

For collection of irrigation fees

with 10% penalty - 5% straight bonus For collection of irrigation fees

with 20% penalty - 10% straight bonus

Where a landowner goes to the office voluntarily to pay his back accounts, 50% of the amount paid shall be credited to the team covering the zone.

4. <u>Conditions precedent to merit bomis for back</u> irrigation fees:

- a. Same conditions as for current irrigation fees above with regards to #emittance of collection and submittal of collection reports.
- b. Same as F2-b above except that the total collections shall be the current and the back accounts and the bases for the systems shall be 50% and 45% respectively.

- G. Division of Bonus:
 - 1. The total bonus for the team shall be divided as follows:

3% - to the team leader

- 75% to the team leader and team members in direct proportion to the total collection of each
- 20% to be divided among the following personnel whose efficiency rating must be at least very satisfactory, and weighted as follows:

Assistant Superintendent - 20% Supervising Vaternaster - 25% Vaternasters, Catekcepers -100% and Ditchtenders

provided that such personnel had actually worked in the zone for at least six (6) months.

However, a Supervising Watermaster who is not a team leader but who undertakes field collection, shall be treated as team member for the corresponding collections made by him in the corresponding zone. A Bill Collector engaged in field collection will be considered in the same category as the Supervising Watermaster, except that in the computation of bonus, his total collection is weighted at 50%.

- 2. Bonus for the Irrigation Superintendent/Officer-In-Charge of the System shall be an amount equal to 2% of the total bonus earned by all teams in the system.
- 3. Bonue for the Regional Irrigation Engineer shall be an amount equal to 1/2% of all bonus earned in the region provided that the total gross collections for the entire region is at least 55% of Base for the Region with no system having a gross collection less than 50% of Base for the System.

II. Cash Avards

A. Cash Awards for Regional Irrigation Engineers

Monetary award of Pl.00 per hectare for incremental benefited area (orop hectare) over the highest registered area in the region beginning Agricultural Year 1965-66 shall be given to the Regional Irrigation Engineer if the increase is due to water management and provided that the gross collection in the region is at least 60% of the Base for the region.

B. <u>Cash Awards for Irrigation Superintendenta/Opficere-In-</u> Charge of Irrigation Systems:

Monetary Award of P3.00 per hectare of incremental benefited area (crop hectare) over the highest registered in the system beginning Agricultural Year 1965-66 shall be given to the Irrigation Superintendents/Officers-InFor a new single system under a Superintendent, or a new system to be grouped with an existing system, the incremental benefited area will be considered only after the following conditions are satisfied:

- 1. Let survey of the total service area is submitted and approved by the Administrator.
- 2. Eighty percent (60%) or more of the service area had been benefited and reasons for inability to benefit the rest of the service area had been submitted and approved by the Administrator.

C. Cash Awards for Watermasters:

- 1. For the most deserving Watermasters in a System with more than 10 divisions:
 - P100.00 cash award 1st most deserving Watermaster 75.00 cash award - 2nd most deserving Watermaster 50.00 cash award - 3rd most deserving Watermaster
- 2. For the most deserving Vatormasters in a system with 6-9 divisions:
 - P 75.00 cash award 1st most deserving Watermaster 50.00 cash award - 2nd most deserving Watermaster
- 3. For the most deserving Watermaster in a system with

3-5 divisions:

P 50.00 cash award - most deserving Watermaster

4. Who may participate in the above awards:

Any watermaster directly supervising an irrigable area of not less than 500 hectares may be considered for evards provided that when a system has less than three divisions, it shall be grouped with one or more systems to form at least three divisions that vill comprise one area of competition.

To merit an award, at least all canals within the division shall be clean, shall have no gaps through which water spills and shall have headwalls and gates (even only wooden gates) in all turnouts. Any section not satisfying the above conditions may be exempted from the assessment if the Vatermaster had presented a formal charge for inefficiency or neglect of duty against the Ditchtender or Gatekeeper in sharge of said section after emerting all efforts to guide him in the proper performance of his duties.

D. Cash Stards for Most Deserving Ditchtender/Catekeepers

1. Systems with 20-40 sections

1 - P100 cash award - 1st most deserving GK/DT
1 - 75 cash award a 2nd most deserving GK/DT
2 - 50 cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

2. Systems with 41 - 70 sections

2 - P100.00 each cash award - 1st most deserving GK/DT 2 - 75.00 each cash award - 2nd most deserving GK/DT 2 - 50.00 each cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

3. Systems with 71-105 sections

F100.00 each cash award - 1st most deserving GK/DT
 75.00 each cash award - 2nd most deserving GK/DT
 50.00 each cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

4. Systems with 106-140 sections

4 - P100.00 each cash award - 1st most deserving GK/DT 4 - 75.00 each cash award - 2nd most deserving GK/DT 4 - 50.00 each cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

5. Systems with 141-175 sections

5 - P100.00 each cash award - 1st most deserving GK/DT 5 - 75.00 each cash award - 2nd most deserving GK/DT 5 - 50.00 each cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

6. Systems with over 175 sections

6 - P100.00 each cashaward - 1st most deserving GK/DT
 6 - 75.00 each cash award - 2nd most deserving GK/DT
 6 50.00 each cash award - 3rd most deserving GK/DT

7. Who may participate in the above awards

All Ditchtenders and Gatekeepers with assigned sections of canals to maintain, whether on the daily or monthly basis, can participate in the above competition for deserving Ditchtender or Gatekeeper and provided further that they have been enjoying such designation for at least one year.

Previous recipients of similar awards may participate every year as long as they perform the duties of a Ditchtender or Gatekeeper.

8. Conditions precedent to merit award

As a minimum requirement, all canals within the section must be clean, all gaps closed and all turnouts must have headwalls and should be gated even with wooden gates.

Systems with lese than 20 sections shall be pooled together or with a bigger system by the Regional Irrigation Engineer to form an area of competition of 30 sections but in no case less than 20 sections.

III. Incentive Bonuses and Cash Awards Committees:

For purposes of the incentive bonuses and cash awards, there is hereby created a Committee on Incentive Bonuses and Cash Awards in theCentral Office and in each Regional Office to be composed of the following:

Central Office Committee:

Likewise, a Committee of Judges is hereby constituted in every Irrigation System or group of Systems whose composition is as follows:

Irrigation Superintendent or Officer-In-Charge - Chairman All Supervising Watermasters and Watermasters - Members

whose functions, duties and responsibilities shall be as hereunder set forth:

Central Office Committee: A.

1. Adopt its rules of procedures.

2. Process, evaluate and decide all recommendations for averds to be elevated to it by the different Regional Committees within the month of October. Basis for verification of supporting papers relative to the award recommended shall be the summary of irrigated lots submitted by Systems as required under NIA Memorandum Circular of September 3, 1965.

B. Regional Office Committee:

1. Adopt its rules of procedures.

- 2. Examince, verify and certify on all statements, reports and other pertinent papers relating to the program submitted to it by the Irrigation Superintendent in his capacity as chairman of the Committee of Judges.
- 3. Submit its recommendation on bomuses on collections to the Central Office Committee on Incentive Bomuses and Cash Awards to be received not lator than the last working day of September following the preceding collection period.
- 4. Make final review and confirm decisions of Committee of Judges regarding best operated division and most deserving watermasters and ditchtenders or gatekcepors.
- 5. Record and file consecutively copies of collection reports, statements and other data relative to the program and specifically maintain charts of collection thereto.
- C. Committee of Judges:

1. Set its rules of procedure.

2. Et@ each ditchtonder or gatekeeper quarterly from October 1 to September 30 of the following year on the same predetermined point system, and submits a summary of same together with its decision to the Regional Committee not later than October 31, for final review and confirmation.

- 3. Rate quarterly from October 1 to September 30 of the following year, in accordance with criteria it shall prepare; each division of the system on the same predetermined point system and submit a summary of same mogether with its decisions to the Regional Committee, not later than October 31, for final review and confirmation. The decision herein shall include determination of most deserving watermasters.
- D. <u>Responsibility of Trrigation Superintendents/Officers-In-</u> Charge of Systems on collection bonus:
 - 1. At any time before the rendition of irrigation bills for each crop, submit the following:
 - a. Layout of system showing the irrigable area by divisions and zones.
 - b. List of collection teams (team leader and team members).
 - 2. Accomplish the attached Collection Reports (See Annexes A, B & C). The Irrigation Superintendents shall forward these reports to the Regional Committee who in turn shall forward same to the Central Office to be received not later than September 30.
 - 3. Maintain a complete file of collection reports, statements and other working papers relative to theprogram for ready reference and specifically, maintain a collection chart of individuals as well as of the teams.
 - 4. These reports shall be forwarded to the Regional Committee not later than the last working day of June following the preceding collection period.

In no case shall cash awards and/or bonuses in favor of an individual exceed the sum of one thousand pesos (F1,000.00) per annum.

All awards shall be reflected in the personal records of all concerned and shall be considered in cases of promotion.

Avarding of cash bonuses and awards to outstanding collectors, personnel and/or teams may be made during the annual Christmas celebration in all NIA Offices.

Active participation of all concerned is hereby enjoined.

This MEMORANDUM CINCULAR supersedes Memorandum Circular Nos. 6 and 51, series of 1968, and shall take effect immediately.
