EXECUTIVE ORDER NO. 386

AUTHORIZING THE ADMINISTRATOR, NATIONAL IRRIGATION  
ADMINISTRATION, TO COORDINATE ALL PUMP IRRIGA-  
TION PROGRAMS.

By virtue of the powers vested in me by law, I,  
FERDINAND E. MARCOS, President of the Philippines, do  
hereby authorize the Administrator, National Irriga-  
tion Administration (NIA), in addition to his regular  
duties as NIA Administrator, to coordinate all pump  
irrigation programs of the national government, in-  
cluding those administered by the Irrigation Service  
Unit of the Department of Public Works and Communica-  
tions and other offices.
