Through your generous financial help, the Philippine Cancer Society was able to extend last year's services to more than 6,748 men and women who came to its Cancer

Detection and Diagnostic Center for free cancer check-up. Of these, the Center found that 372 were positive for cancer and it referred them to their private physicians or, in the case of indigents, to public hospitals equipped in handling cancer cases.

Once again, the Society has been authorized by President Ferdinand E. Marcos to conduct its yearly fund campaign. Enclosed is a copy of the Presidential Proclamation covering the 1972 drive.

In the name of the Society, may we appeal once more for your generous assistance?

If it is not imposing much on your kindheartedness, we shall deeply be elated if you can forward a larger donation this year due to the present increased costs of medical equipment and supplies.


