## Submission of License Certificate to Exercise Profession with Any Proposed Appointment of Watchman or Security Guard,

Reproduced hereunder for their information and compliance is Memorandum Circular No. 6, s. 1973 of the Civil Service Commission dated June 5, 1973, on the subject mentioned above, which is self-explanatory.

Republic Act No. 5487, as amended by Presidential Republic Act No. 5487, as amended by Presidential Decree No. 11 dated October 3, 1972 and No. 11-A dated January 17, 1973, otherwise known as "The Private Security Agency Law," provides:

Sec. 3. Definition of Terms - x x x

XXX XXX XXX

"(d) Watchman or Security Guard: Watchman or Security Guard Agency. - Any person who offers or renders personal service to watch or secure residential or business establishment, or both, or any building, compound or area, including but not limited to logging concessions, agricultural, mining or pasture lands, for hire or compensation, or as employee thereof, including any employee of the national or local government or any agency or instrumentality thereof and of government-owned or controlled firms or corporations, who is employed to watch or secure government buildings, compounds, premises, and other properties, x x x" (Emphasis supplied) A THE AND ALL AND ALL

shall engage in the business of, or not either as a private detective, or detective agency; and either engage in the occupation, calling or employment of watchman or in the business of watchman's agency without first having obtained the necessary permit from the Chief, Philippine Constabulary, which permit as approved is a prerequisite in obtaining a license certificate; x x x.<sup>#</sup>

In accordance with the abovequoted provisions of law, all proposed appointments to the position of Watchman or Security Guard submitted to this Office for attestation must be accompaned by a copy of the respective License to Exercise Profession (FOSIA Form No. 4) as Watchman or Security Guard issued by the Philippine Constabulary. Appointments submitted to this Office without a copy of the required license will be returned to the respective offices without action.

With respect to those watchmen or security guards who are already employed and whose appointments have already been attested by this Office, a copy of their respective License to Exercise Profession of Watchman or Security Guard (PCSIA Form No. 4) must be submitted to this Office within fifteen (15) days from receipt of this Memorandum Circular.
