SUBJECT : <u>Guidelines Promulgated by CSC on Veteran Preference Given</u> in a Civil Service Examination

MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

TO

: ALL HEADS OF DEPARTMENTS, BUREAUS AND OFFICES OF THE NATIONAL AND LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, INCLU-DING GOVERNMENT-OWNED OR CONTROLLED CORPORATION

SUBJECT : Veterans Preference

In order to clarify the provisions of Section 10, Rule I of the Civil Service Rules on Personnel Actions and Policies, approved by the President on November 20, 1975, the following guidelines are hereby promulgated:

1. The term "veterans" as used in the forecited provision includes (1) veterans of World War II, (2) former or honorably discharged members of the Philippine Expeditionary Force to Korea or members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines who rendered similar services in the Philippines or abroad, and (3) honorably discharged members of the Armed Forces of the Philippines who have rendered at least (3) years military service therein or those whose services were sconer terminated due to service-connected disability or death in line of duty.

2. That the disabled veterans and their wives and the widows of the veterans are entitled to veterans preference under the following circumstances:

(a) Where the disabled veterans availed himself of veterans preference in a civil service examination, his wife is not entitled to veterans preference unless the veteran forfeits his civil service eligibility earned by virtue of veterans preference. (b) Where the disabled veteran has not availed himself of veterans preference, his wife is entitled to said preference and her enjoyment thereof bars the former from enjoying the same unless the latter forfeits her enjoyment thereof in favor of the former,

(c) The widow of a veteran is entitled to veterans preference whether or not the veteran had availed himself of veterans preference during his lifetime.

This Memorandum Circular shall take effect immediately.
