Standard Features of the Official Seal of the NIA

MC # 60, S. 1976 had been issued in order to disseminate the widespread use of the new NIA logo in all our field offices. However, after all these years it had been observed that all kinds of odd shapes and colors have been used contrary to the standards set in the original logo.

In order to achieve an accurate and uniform standard for our official seal, you are hereby directed to check immediately all your respective logo signs and make the necessary corrections and changes according to the following specifications: 1. Shape - a perfect circle with no border as shown in attached sample; and 2. Color - white and green. (The white symbol on the green field is actually NIA carved in a style suggestive of flowing water.)

Since the logo stands for the agency, care must be taken to avoid distortion or variation in either the style or color. The circular background upon which NIA is carved should always be in brilliant green. However, in black and white printing, black may replace green or simply specify that the NIA be reversed on a circular black field as shown in Sample No. 2.
