SUBJECT : DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY ON PAYMENTS OF BACK ACCOUNTS

Several policies had already been formulated to encourage irrigation users to pay their back accounts, such as the incentive policy for back accounts under MC No. 005, S. 1988 and the collection incentive given to Irrigator's Associations (IA) under the Type II contract. Moreover, much effort had already been exerted by NIA's field personnel to collect back accounts.

Despite these efforts, however, many back accounts are still difficult to collect because portions are disowned or disputed by the end-users. To hasten the collection process, the Irrigation Superintendents are hereby given authority to negotiate with the end-users to establish their real obligations. The results of such negotiations shall be signed by the Irrigation Superintendents and the end-users, copy furnished the Regional Irrigation Manager/Operations Manager. The Irrigation Superintendents may then grant the incentives under MC #005, S. 1988 on the payment of the undisputed amounts.

The amounts disowned or disputed by the end-users shall no longer be included in the future statements of accounts to be sent to them. However, these shall remain in the books as outstanding back accounts subject to later resolution by due process or until such time that write off or condonation is authorized.

Please be guided accordingly.
