## MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

SUBJECT : MEDICARE CIRCULAR # 278, 1991

For the information, guidance and compliance of all concerned, quoted hereunder is Medicare Circular # 278, 1991.

MEDICARE CIRCULAR No. 278-1991

TO : All Government Employees, Government Agencies and Offices, and Accredited Hospitals

SUBJECT : Submission of other Documentary requirements for Medicare Claims

Records of the Medicare Department of the Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) show that a significant number of Medicare claims had been filed in behalf of persons who are not or no longer Medicare members or whose membership are of doubtful status. It is also found out that several members denied that they have been hospitalized during certain periods as appearing in Medicare claims filed in their behalf.

To protect the contributions of the majority of Medicare members to the Health Insurance Fund from undue or unnecessary utilization and in order to establish a credible Medicare membership data - base, the Philippine Medical Care Commission, through Board Resolution No. 91-2241, requires the submission to the hospital by the GSIS member of any one of several documents tending to prove that he is presently employed or had been employed within at least three months during the twelve-month period prior to admission of patient in the hospital.

Effective May 1, 1991, Medicare members shall be required to submit any of the following, in addition to PMCC Form I:

- 1. Xerox copy of the <u>first page</u> of the GSIS member's <u>policy contract/Certificate</u> of <u>Membership</u> (CM) or <u>Term Renewable Insurance</u> (TR) certified by the <u>nearest GSIS Branch Office</u> or certified by his <u>employer who is the same person certifying his</u> <u>premium payment in the IMCC Form I for the</u> initial confinement of a member/dependent; or
- 2. Correct GSIS policy contract number (as verified by the billing clerk from its records on file) for subsequent confinements of the member or any of his legal dependents in the same hospital after the xerox copy of the first page of the GSIS policy contract was already submitted to the hospital; or
- 3. A certified true or xerox copy of the member's original appointment; or
- 4. Certified true or xerox copy of the member's service record; or
- 5. Military field personnel who do not have ready access to any of the above requirements may submit instead a true or xerox copy of the following certified by their Commanding Officer.
  - 5.1 Identification Card (ID) or
  - 5.2 Latest pay Slip

Hospitals are encouraged to find a way of keeping some sort of record of the member's GSIS policy contract number for their reference in subsequent confinement of the Medicare beneficiary in connection with no. 27 above.

Hospitals, however, are advised to suspend the implementation of the GSIS Memorandum dated October 15, 1990 governing the submission of any one of the above documents until the end of April of this year. Previous claims returned by GSIS for lack of any of the above requirements may be rofiled for payment. Heads of government agencies/units are enjoined to instruct their

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personnel who have no GSIS policy contract yet to secure the corresponding GSIS policy contract at the nearest GSIS Branch Office regardless of employment status.
