SUBJECT

CELEBRATION OF THE EIGHT NATIONAL STATISTICS MONTH IN OCTOBER 1997

1. Purpose

This Memorandum Circular is issued to enjoin all Bureaus, Regional Field Units (RFUs) and attached Agencies under the Department of Agriculture (DA) to actively participate in and support the celebration of the Eight National Statistics Month (NSM) in October 1997 pursuant to Presidential Proclamation No. 647, "Declaring the month of October of every year as the National Statistics Month."

2 Objectives

The observance of the NSM has the objectives, viz.: (a) to promote, enhance and instill nationwide awareness and appreciation of the importance and value of statistics to the different sectors of society, and (b) elicit the cooperation and support of the general public in upgrading the quality and standard of statistics in the country.

3. Theme and Sub-Themes-

Cognizant to the vision of the government till the year 2000, the Seventh NSM has this overall theme:

"Wastong Estadistika sa Pagsulong ng Siyensiya at Teknolohiya -- Haligi ng Matalag na Bansa"

"Accurate Statistics in the Advancement of Science and Technology --Foundation of a Strong Nation"

Each agency may choose to have its own sub-theme depending on the focus and direction of its statistical activities

4. Coordination of Activities at the National and Regional Levels

The National Statistical Coordination Board (NSCB) has created the NSM Committee to oversee and coordinate the implementation of the various activities and programs to be undertaken during the month-long celebration. This is composed of representatives from the major statistical agencies, government departments and agencies, academic institutions, and the private sector.

A Working Group drawn from the NSCB Technical Staff serves as the Secretariat to the Committee.

At the regional level, the RFU Directors are hereby advised to coordinate with the Regional Statistical Coordination Committees (RSCCs). They are designated as the coordinating bodies for all NSM activities in their respective region. In areas where there are no NSCB Regional Units, the RSCC in the region will provide technical and administrative support in this undertaking.

5. Suggested Activities

Activities that may be undertaken by each bureau, RFU or attached agency may be in the form of seminars, symposia, exhibits, statistical quiz show, motorcade, slide shows, and publication of statistical reports, indicators and other relevant information, and hanging of streamers, with particular emphasis on the theme and the agency's/region's selected sub-theme, if any.

The participating agencies are requested to provide their own NSM streamers to be displayed at their building facade throughout the month of October. They are also encouraged to disseminate the calendar of activities, posters and other promotional materials within their offices.

Agencies are further requested to earmark an amount to cover agencyspecific activities and other related activities during the celebration of the NSM.

6. Submission of Agency Activities

All DA bureaus, RFUs, and attached agencies are requested to submit a detailed listing of their proposed activities using the attached format to the NSM Committee through the NSCB, 2nd and 5th floors, Midland Buendia Building, 403 Senator Gil Puyat Avenue Ext., Makati City 1200, Metro Manila on or before 31. July 1997, in order to synchronize all efforts for the celebration. All concerned are hereby urged to cooperate in ensuring the attainment of the objectives of the NSM.
