MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR

T O : All Officials and Employees

SUBJECT : **WEARING OF THE FILIPINIANA ATTIRE IN OBSERVANCE
OF THE PHILIPPINE CENTENNIAL CELEBRATION**

In observance of the Philippine Centennial Celebration and pursuant to CSC MC # 20, S. 1997, all women employees/officials of Central and field offices are hereby required to wear Filipiniana attire (Kinona, patadyong, malong, etc.) as a symbol of the rebirth of the Filipino identity.


The wearing of the Filipiniana attire shall commence on Monday, October 6, 1997 and on all 1st Mondays of the month until December 1998. Male employees shall continue to wear the prescribed uniform.

In this connection, the following guidelines are hereby promulgated, viz:

1. All female employees of this office should wear their Filipiniana attire on the 1st Mondays of the month until 1998;
2. The choice of their Filipiniana attire shall be left to the discretion of each employee/official provided it does not hamper their movement/flexibility while in the performance of their duties;
3. Personnel who are exempted in this Circular are the following:
 - a. those who are on field work
 - b. ladies on the family way
 - c. those in mourning (immediate family)

Inasmuch as this event comes only once in our lifetime, the wholehearted support and cooperation of each and everyone shall truly leave a lasting legacy in our present and future generations to come.

Compliance is hereby enjoined.
