SUBJECT: REMITTANCE/PROCESSING OF MEDICARE CLAIMS

SUBJECT : Turn-over of the MHP Functions of the GSIS to the
Philippine Health Insurance Corporation

The Government Service Insurance System (GSIS) and the
Philippine Health Insurance Corporation (PHIC) signed on
September 3, 1977 a Memorandum of Agreement (MOA) transferring
the administration of Medicare Program I to the latter in
compliance with the provisions of the National Health Insurance
Act of 1977 (R.A. 77875) effective immediately. The MOA was
signed by Mr. Cesar M. Sarino, President and General Manager of
the Government Service Insurance System and Atty. Jose G. Fabia,
President and Chief Executive Officer of the Philippine Health
Insurance Corporation in the presence of senior officials of both
agencies.

Pursuant to the conditions agreed and stipulated in the RUA, all claims received on or after October 1, 1997 will be processed and paid by the Claims Processing Department of the Philippine Health Insurance Corporation, JOCKER building, Diliman, Quezon City (near Ever Gotesco).

The GSIS will continue processing and paying all claims received prior to October 1, 1997 and shall wind up its operations on or before December 31, 1997.

Claims for SSS and OCW beneficiaries will be filed as usual with the nearest SSS Branches and OWWA Offices.

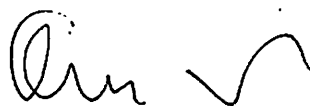
Premiums/contributions of employees and employers will continuously be remitted to the GSIS Office until December 31, 1997. Effective January 1, 1998, Philhealth shall collect all premiums/contributions.

All concerned are enjoined to observe this policy.
