SUBJECT: SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES TO MC # 41, S. 1997

The objective of granting the Centennial Anniversary Bonus (CAB) is to serve as an incentive for every official/employee to participate actively in Agency activities being undertaken in preparation for the centennial anniversary celebration of our country.

One such activity is the wearing of native attire during Monday flag-raising ceremonies.

In order therefore to promote the success of this activity, and sustain the spirit of nationalism and patriotism within us, the following guidelines shall form part of the provisions of MC # 41, s. 1997 on the grant of CAB which reads as follows:


"Sec.2.3 The wearing of the official ladies uniform prescribed to be worn on Mondays is hereby suspended on first Mondays of the month commencing immediately and culminating in December 1998. The native attire shall be worn in its stead as per MC # 35, s. 1997 during the said days/period."

"Sec.2.4 All male officials/employees are hereby required to wear native attire (Filipino Barong, Barong Tagalog variations, Camisa-Tsino/Rural Trouser with panuelo, Tribal/Ethnic costumes) similarly on first Mondays of the month subject to pertinent guidelines of MC # 35, s. 1997."

For offices with no office uniform as yet, the native attire shall likewise be worn on first Mondays of the month as herein prescribed. This will pave the way for a coordinated and synchronized celebration.

The wholehearted support and cooperation of each and everyone is enjoined.

This supplemental Circular shall take effect immediately.
