SUBJECT: DIRECTIONS FOR RICE SEEDS SYSTEM PROGRAM IMPLEMENTATION

SUBJECT: <u>MAJOR POLICY DIRECTIONS FOR RICE SEEDS SYSTEM PROGRAM</u> IMPLEMENTATION

Please be informed of the major policy directions issued by Undersecretary Domingo F. Panganiban during the Program Implementation Review in RFU XII and DAF-ARMM held last September 21-22, 2000.

- 1. For the dry cropping season, all program areas shall have a Municipal Rice Seed System Action Plan containing the following:
 - a. Hectarage of program and non-program areas.
 - b. Seed requirement (variety, quantity, timing of availability)
 - c. Sources of seeds (Binhian sa Lalawigan, DA-NFA, etc.)
 - d. Implementation Scheme and Schedules. (a. masterlisting of farmers,
 b. procurement and distribution, c. planting operations, d. Deployment of Technicians).

- e. Institutional arrangements with the LGU as the lead implementor with DA-RFU, NFA and other allied agencies (NIA, BPI, ATI, PHILRICE, BSWM, among others), providing facilitative and technical support.
- f. Seed loan collection scheme for the Binhian sa Lalawigan and DA-NFA...

The spirit behind the preparation of the Municipal Rice Seed System Action Plan as issued in the Memorandum dated September 25, 2000, is to make the LGUs responsible and accountable for the operationalization of their respective Rice Production Program anchored on the Rice Seeds System Action Program. An involved and proactive LGU taking a lead role in program planning, implementation and monitoring shall institutionalize the Rice Seeds System Action Program as their vehicle to achieve food security.

- 2. The target area for the next cropping season and onwards must be validated by NIA, Provincial/Municipal Agriculturist and Regional Seed Coordinator,, whether such area is covered by NIS, CIS, SWIP/DD and/or STW.
- 3. NFA shall not accept the masterlist of farmers without proper certification of NIA and endorsement of Municipal Agriculturist, Provincial Agriculturist and DA Regional Authorities.
- 4. Each province shall have 3-5 varieties only of palay certified seeds available for procurement. These varieties should be the varieties that have performed well at the Rice Techno-Demos evaluated by PHILRICE.
- 5. Farmers can still plant Rc-10 and Rc-18 varieties, but NFA has the option not to procure the produce of said varieties.
- 6. Certified seeds procured by NFA must be distributed within one week.
- 7. DA is pursuing the promotion of hybrid palay seeds to increase the area planted to 50,000 hectares by year 2002. As such, potential hybrid seed growers and F1 growers should be identified and enlisted for training and the availment of assistance.
- 8. Organic fertilizer application should be pursued thru composting to improve the soil condition in the rice lands.
- 9. Retooling of technicians shall be arranged between DA and LGUs.
- 10. Financing for production shall be closely coordinated with LBP and Quedancor and full assistance shall be given to farmer-borrowers.
