The Regional Program Coordinators with the assistance of the Action Officers for Inbred and Hybrid Rice shall:

- 1. Provide a unified program implementation in particular the GMA Rice Program, in the regional field units, cooperating bureaus, attached agencies, and other stakeholders;
- 2. Provide day-to-day supervision of the program;
- 3. Undertake operational monitoring and evaluation activities; and
- 4. Report to the Secretary through the Undersecretary and Assistant Secretary for Field Operations, and GMA Rice Program Coordinator.

## C. Program Secretariat/Coordinators:

The Program Secretariat/Coordinators shall:

- 1. Analyze and consolidate reports;
- 2. Conduct periodic field monitoring and program implementation;
- 3. Coordinate with DA-RFUs, LGUs and other offices involved in the implementation of the program; and
- 4. Provide other technical and staff support to the Program Director, Regional Program Coordinators, and the Action Officers for Inbred and Hybrid rice.

As such, travelling and other incidental expenses of the TWG members, Regional Program Coordinators and Action Officers for Inbred and Hybrid Rice and the Program Secretariat/Coordinators to be incurred in the performance of their tasks shall be charged against the Ginintuang Masaganang Ani Rice Program funds, subject to the availability of funds and to usual accounting and auditing rules and procedures.

This Special Order shall take effect immediately and supercedes other orders inconsistent herewith.
