**Subject: IMPOSITION OF A FEE ON THE ACCREDITATION OF AN MNSA OR MPSA
DEGREE AS EQUIVALENT TO THE CES WRITTEN EXAMINATION**

To defray the necessary expenses, the CESB adopted a policy imposing an accreditation fee of one thousand pesos (P1,000.00) as a requirement for the accreditation of MNSA and MPSA degrees as equivalent to the CES written examination.

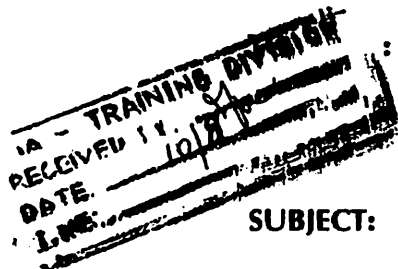

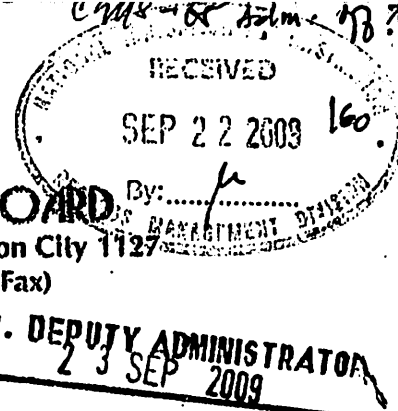

SUBJECT: IMPOSITION OF A FEE ON THE ACCREDITATION OF AN MNSA OR MPSA DEGREE AS EQUIVALENT TO THE CES WRITTEN EXAMINATION.

The Career Executive Service Board (CESB) through Section 13, Rule II of Circular No. 2 s. 2009 (Revised Integrated Rules on the Grant of CES Eligibility) accredited the Master in National Security Administration (MNSA) and Master in Public Safety Administration (MPSA) degrees conferred by the National Defense College of the Philippines (NDCP) and Philippine Public Safety College (PPSC), respectively as equivalent to the CES Written Examination - the first of the four-stage CES eligibility examination process - provided that the holder thereof is an appointee to at least a division chief level position (SG 24) or its equivalent in the government, regardless of whether he/she is in the career or non-career service with at least three (3) years managerial experience. In case the MNSA or MPSA degree holder is appointed to a non-career position, he/she should have served the government for at least three (3) years at the time of the application.

To defray the necessary expenses, the Board, through Resolution No. 806 dated July 10, 2009, adopted a policy imposing an accreditation fee of one thousand pesos (P 1,000.00) as a requirement for the accreditation of MNSA and MPSA degrees as equivalent to the CES Written Examination.

In this regard, all concerned are formally notified for their information and guidance.

This Circular takes effect immediately.
